Greetings, Members and Friends!

I hope this newsletter finds you and yours well and enjoying summer. The ACA board has been actively working to implement some changes to improve club membership and services (see Board meeting minutes). The Board reviewed the ACA bylaws and did a bit of housekeeping to align verbiage and reflect change. Change in bylaws requires 2/3 passage by the Board and passage by simple majority from the general membership. Please keep an eye on your email for a ballot to cast your vote in the near future.

The biggest change that affects our general membership comes in the scheduling of membership meetings. The Kiwanis of Portage Lakes has approved the change to Sunday afternoon membership meetings and presentations. The rationale for the change is to free up Friday nights for potential observatory impromptu star parties and improve meeting attendance for all ages. Transportation during night hours will no longer be a deterrent for ACA youth and other members.

The Board also decided to build a social media presence by creating an ACA Instagram account and Facebook page. A presence in social media will give the club needed exposure to a diverse population. The accounts will be monitored by a board member to ensure appropriate content.

As we move closer to the 2022-2023 ACA membership year, I invite you to become active members: attend meetings and presentations, attend star parties at the observatory, share your ideas and thoughts with the board via email, serve on the board, and submit an article to the publications editor pertaining to astronomy.

We are dedicated to the informal study of astronomy and related sciences, and promoting the interest and education of members and the public in amateur (observational) astronomy. WHEN: Sunday, August 14, 2 to 5 PM


WHO: Members and their family/friends




Observatory Report
