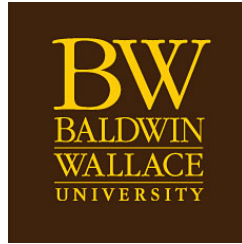

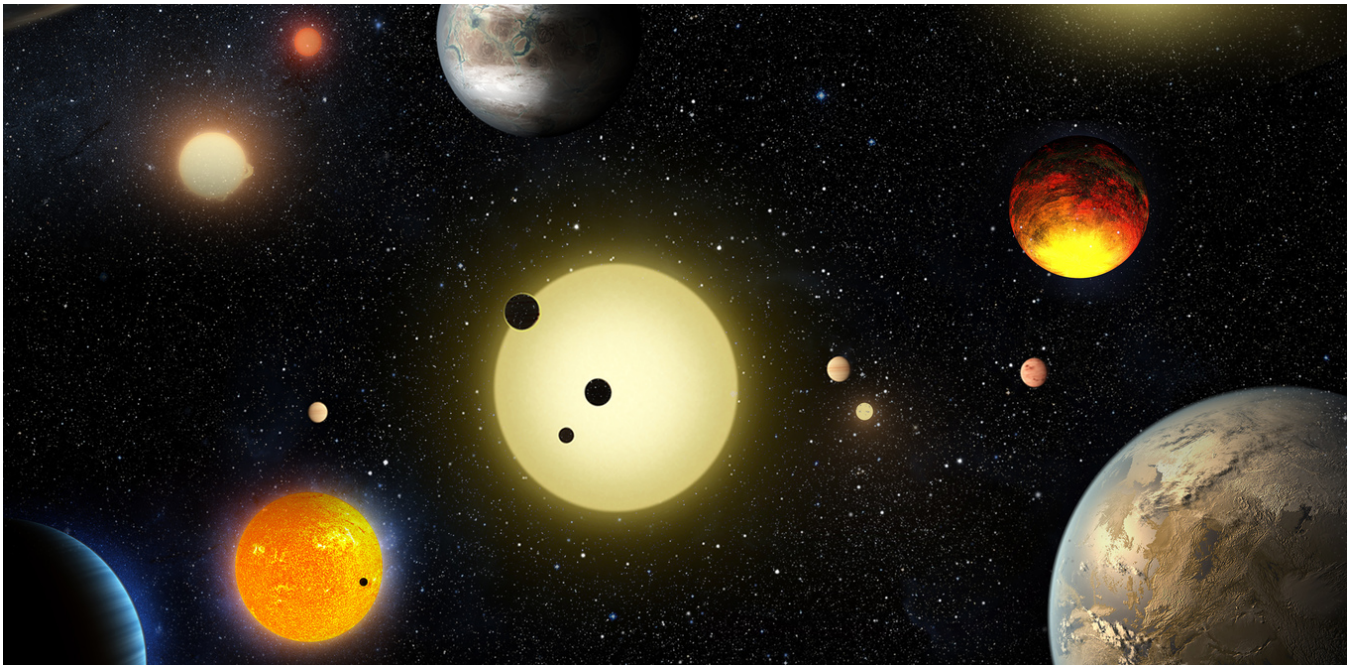


"The Parent Stars of Exoplanets"

The Burrell Observatory is proud to host an open house program on Friday October 13, 2017 at 7:30 PM. Dr. Marc Pinsonneault of The Ohio State University will present a lecture on the stars that have planets. With over 3500 exoplanets discovered so far, the implications for the discovery of extraterrestrial life are tremendous.

The lecture will be presented in the "Center for Innovation and Growth" (CIG) 340 Front Street Berea.

After the lecture, the Burrell Observatory will be open for viewing, weather permitting.

This is a free lecture and no reservations are required. The CIG is located the East side of Front Street, North of Bagley Road at 340 Front Street.
